Local and National Breweries Featured in 4th Annual Craft Brew Races Stowe

Stowe, VT— National beer and running event series, the Craft Brew Races, will return to Stowe on May 20th, 2017 for the fourth consecutive year. A portion of the proceeds from the Stowe Craft Brew Race will be donated to the Stowe Land Trust.

The Stowe Craft Brew Race is 3.1 mile/5K run (or walk), featuring a beautiful tour of the Vermont countryside. Starting at Stowe Lake Mountain Resort and Spa, the course runs out on Cape Cod Road before turning on to the Stowe Bike Path, crossing the West Branch Little River on multiple bridges. The finish line is mere steps from the beer festival. In addition to included beer samples at the festival, water, Polar Seltzer and Kind Snacks will be available to runners, and food vendors will be on site. Designated driver and festival-only tickets are available.

More than 1,400 craft brew lovers participated in the event in 2016, and it is expected to reach capacity in 2017. The run starts at noon, with the festival doors opening at 12:30. All 5K participants and festival-goers receive a pint glass and entry to the festival — including beer sampling, live music, vendors and food trucks selling onsite. All designated driver ticket-holders receive a different bracelet at registration, and are welcome to enjoy the festival, designated snacks, and non-alcoholic beverages.

More than 40 breweries will be pouring samples of their brews at the festival. Visit craftbrewraces.com for a full vendor list and to purchase event tickets.
